DIRECTIONS

Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital
One Robert Wood Johnson Place
New Brunswick, NJ 08903

From New Jersey Turnpike: Take exit #9 (New Brunswick) and proceed on Route 18 North, approximately two miles to Route 27 South - Princeton, to the fourth traffic light (by railroad station). ***Make a right onto Easton Avenue. Proceed one block and make a left at the next traffic light onto Somerset Street. Proceed one block to the 1st traffic light and make a left onto Little Albany Street. The hospital is on the right hand side.***

From Southern New Jersey: Take Route 18 North to Route 27 South (Princeton exit). ***Follow bold italicized directions above.***

From Route 1 (North or South): Take Route 18 North to Route 27 South (Princeton exit). ***Follow bold italicized directions above.***

From Garden State Parkway: Exit Route 1 South. Proceed approximately 8 miles to Route 18 North. (Princeton exit). ***Follow bold italicized directions above.***

From Route 287: Take exit #10 (formerly exit #6) "Route 527/Easton Ave/New Brunswick". Continue on Easton Avenue for approximately 6 miles. Make a right onto Somerset Street. Proceed one block to the first traffic light and make a left onto Little Albany Street. The hospital is on the right hand side.

PARKING

Gravel Parking: Just past parking deck.

Street Parking: You may find parking on Somerset and Little Albany Street.

Parking Deck: There will be a few parking spots available in the hospital parking deck on Little Albany Street, past the Emergency Room Entrance. If necessary, your parking will be validated at the forum.

For Handicap Accessibility to Robert Wood Johnson Auditorium Side Door: Proceed past Little Albany Street and make your next left to the outside wheelchair ramp near Bristol-Myers Squibb Children's Hospital. This ramp will take you to a side door of the Robert Wood Johnson Auditorium. Please knock on this door and you will be able to enter until the Ed Forum starts at 12:00 pm.
