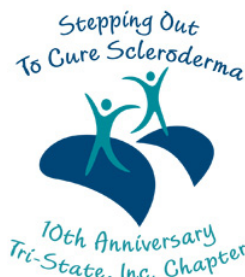
*The mission of the Scleroderma Foundation Tri-State, Inc. Chapter is three fold:*
