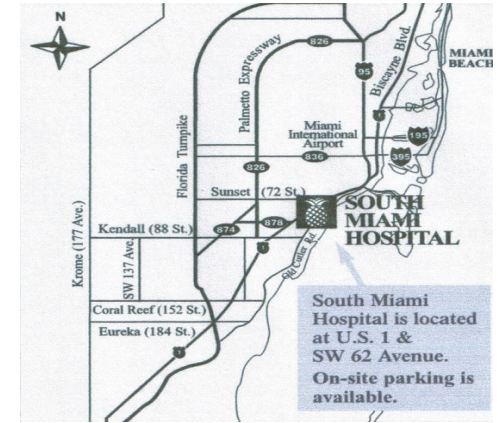
Debra P. Fertel, MD
