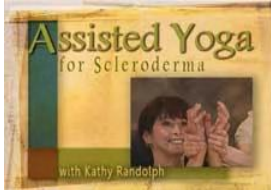

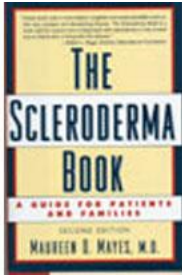
Assisted Yoga for Scleroderma, with Kathy Randolph
