From the EAST: Exit 481 N at Northern Blvd; turn left on Northern Blvd and proceed to Taft Rd; turn right on Taft and proceed to Buckley Rd; turn left on Buckley Rd and proceed to North Medical Center.

From the WEST: Exit 690 E at Hiawatha Blvd, turn left on Hiawatha Blvd and enter 81 N at 7th North St; turn right on 7th North St to Buckley Rd; turn right on Buckley and proceed to North Medical Center.

From the NORTH: Exit 81 S at Taft Rd; turn right on Taft to Buckley Rd; turn left on Buckley Rd. and proceed to North Medical Center.

From the SOUTH: Exit 81 N at 7th North St; turn right on 7th North St to Buckley Rd; turn right on Buckley Rd and proceed to North Medical Center.

From the THRUWAY: Exit 36 (Syracuse I-81) proceed to 81 S to 7th North St; turn right on 7th North St. to Buckley Rd, turn right on Buckley Rd. and proceed to North Medical Center.
