The responsibilities of the Scleroderma Foundation Michigan Chapter's Board of Directors include:

- 1.** Giving and/or fundraising a minimum of \$500 a year to support the Scleroderma Foundation (in-kind or financial).
- 2.** Attending five board meetings per year (held in Southfield and the surrounding areas from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.) and the strategic planning session held in November with active participation. Regular meetings are held on the third Monday of January, March, May, July and September. Planned absences need to be reported to the Executive Director prior to the scheduled meeting.
- 3.** Reviewing all board materials prior to board meetings.
- 4.** Reviewing and responding to all e-mail correspondences in a prompt manner.
- 5.** Familiarizing oneself with the mission, vision and current fundraising efforts of the chapter and reviewing the chapter website to stay up-to-date.
- 6.** Actively participating in fundraising efforts of the chapter, which currently include the Stampede Scleroderma Detroit Zoo run/walk in June.
- 7.** Becoming a member of the Scleroderma Foundation Michigan Chapter at a minimum level of \$25 per year.
- 8.** Being a visionary and leader, using your skills and talents to increase awareness, and promoting fundraising efforts and educational experiences for the Michigan Chapter.
- 9.** Adhering to all of the national and local policies of the Scleroderma Foundation including conflict of interest, confidentiality and fiduciary responsibilities.
- 10.** Assisting in the recruitment of event sponsors, donors, and other board members for the Michigan Chapter.
